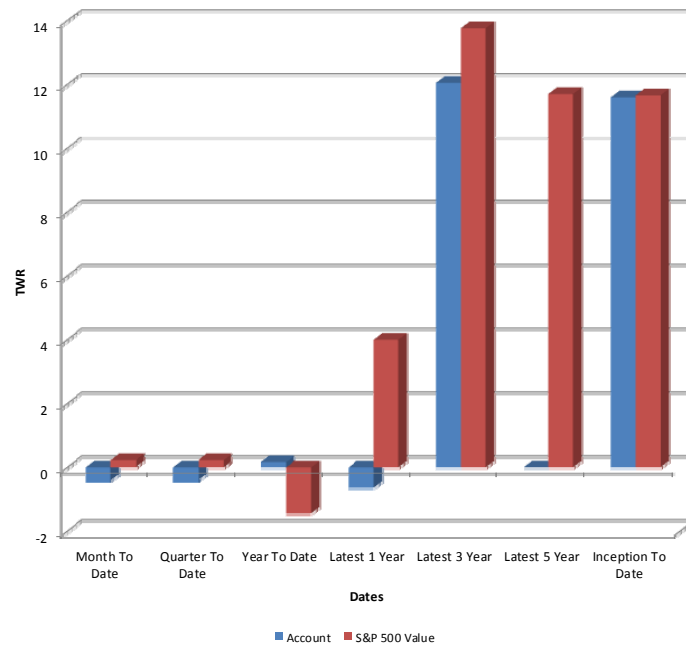

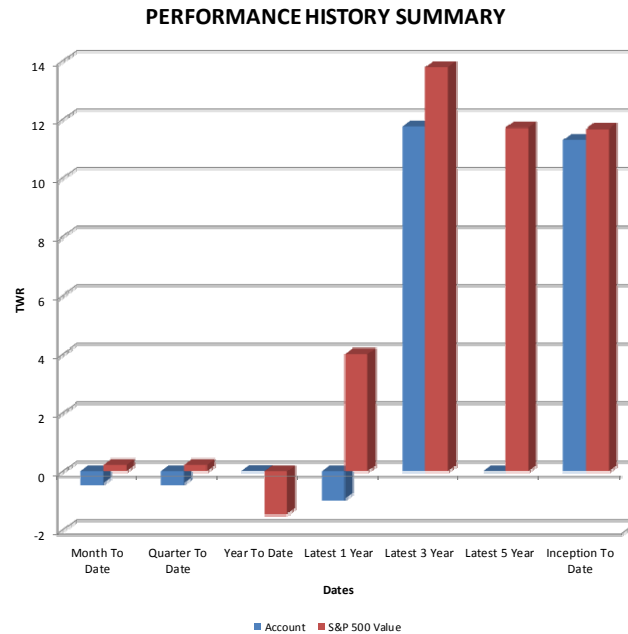

Large Cap Value Commentary**

U.S. public equities posted modestly positive returns during the month of July as the Greek crisis, fears of a stock market panic in China and the Iran nuclear negotiations dominated the global news headlines. All of the major U.S. equity indices gained positive ground. The S&P 500 Value Index rose 0.22% during the month of July. Performance was mixed as five out of ten GICS sectors in the benchmark outperformed. The leading sectors in the benchmark were Utilities (up approximately 6% for the month of July), Consumer Staples (up approximately 5%) and Financials (up 3%). The laggards for the month included Materials (down 9%), Energy (down 9%) and Industrials (down approximately 2%).

The Herndon Large Cap Value portfolio underperformed the S&P 500 Value over the month, falling approximately 0.43% despite outperformance in seven out of ten respective sectors and/or the S&P 500 Value benchmark. For the month, stock selection was positive while sector allocation was the primary detractor from relative performance. In terms of allocation, the portfolio's overweight position in the underperforming Energy sector was the largest drag on performance.

The portfolio's most pronounced relative overweight sectors continued to be Energy, Technology and Materials. The portfolio's largest relative underweights continued to be in the Health Care, Utilities and Financials sectors.

The portfolio sectors with the greatest relative contribution for the month of July were Industrials (up 3%, with 56 bps impact), Consumer Discretionary (up approximately 6%, with 32 bps impact) and Technology (up approximately 1%, with 25 bps impact). The portfolio sectors with the lowest level of relative contribution for July were Energy (down approximately 9%, with 99 bps impact), Financials (up 1%, with 52 bps impact) and Materials (down 9%, with 31 bps impact).

The top three positive individual stock contributors during the month were Lockheed Martin (+11.4% return), Altria Group (+11.2% return) and CBOE (+8.3% return). These stocks represent holdings from the Industrials, Consumer Staples and Financials sectors respectively. Lockheed Martin (LMT), a global defense design and development company, continues to rise on improved sentiment following M&A activity and 2nd quarter results that exceeded expectations. Altria Group (MO), a tobacco and alcohol company, is benefitting from increased revenue from their wine segment along with increased sale volumes and higher pricings on tobacco products. CBOE (CBOE), the operator of an exchange focused on ETFs, options and derivatives trading, had increased investor enthusiasm as their current ROE exceeds their peer average by 3x while having no debt on their balance sheet.

The three stocks that detracted from performance the most during the month were Continental Resources (-21.2% return), SM Energy (-19.6% return), and Apache (-20.0%). Continental Resources (CLR), SM Energy (SM) and Apache (APA), are oil exploration and production companies in the Energy sector which experienced a decline in performance reflective of the current market on the price of oil.

During the month of July, the portfolio's position in Copa Holdings increased while positions in Baxter International, Colgate-Palmolive and Ross Stores were decreased. Positions were initiated in Accenture, Alliance Data Systems, Chesapeake Energy, Credit Acceptance, Harris, Hewlett-Packard, Mastercard, Noble and Tesoro. The portfolio's positions in AES, Aflac, Allergan, Endo International and Verizon Communications were eliminated. The net impact of the trades had just minor impacts on the overall relative sector exposure. Exposure to Energy, Industrials and Technology increased, while exposure to Consumer Discretionary, Health Care, Telecom and Utilities declined. All other sectors essentially remained the same, with the exception of market appreciation or depreciation.
